- 92% of teens post their name on their online profiles.
- 58% of teens don't think posting personal info online is unsafe.
- 69% of teens regularly receive personal messages online from strangers and most of them don't tell a trusted adult.
- On average, teens spend 5 hours and 38 minutes online every day.

## State Assessments

Diocesan and State assessments are just around the corner. Teachers prepare students every year for standardized testing by aligning instruction with required state standards throughout the school year. These tests are important and should be taken seriously. Taking tests can be somewhat stressful at times so we want the children to have the best possible environment in which to complete the series of tests. Realizing it is good practice all year round, you may help your child be alert and prepared by doing the following:

1. Ensure a good night's sleep
2. Be sure your child eats breakfast before school
3. Schedule vacations and appointments outside of the school day
4. Encourage them each day to keep trying and do their very best.

The Assessment schedule is as follows:

- ✓ March 14-16 Social Science (6,8)
- ✓ April 16,17,18 Technology (4,6,8)
- ✓ April 25,26 Typing (4,5)
- ✓ April 17-26 Reading (3-8)
- ✓ April 17-26 Math (3-8)
- ✓ April 24-25 Science (5,8)

**Most students who are language learners have already taken the K-ELPA2. However, the state required that students in grades 3-8 must pass the Reading and Math test scores. Per Diocesan policy #402, students not passing the state assessments with scores lower than the #3 range, shall be required for Summer School. State Assessments need completed by end of April. Please continue to progress monitor your students in order to accomplish the necessary goals for promotion to the next grade level. The teachers and I look forward to sharing with you your child's progress this school year.**

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| <p><b>Ingredients</b></p> <p>3 cups Flour<br/>         2 teaspoons cinnamon<br/>         1 teaspoon baking soda<br/>         1 teaspoon ginger<br/>         1 teaspoon nutmeg<br/>         1/2 teaspoon cloves<br/>         1/2 teaspoon salt<br/>         1 1/2 cups sugar<br/>         1/2 cup brown sugar packed<br/>         1/2 cup vegetable oil<br/>         1/2 Cup applesauce<br/>         3 eggs<br/>         3/4 cup milk<br/>         2 teaspoons vanilla extract<br/>         2 1/2 cups carrots coarsely shredded<br/>         1 Cup raisins<br/>         1/2 Cup chopped pecans, optional<br/>         Cream cheese frosting</p> <p><a href="https://www.kids-cooking-activities.com/kids-Easter-recipes.html">https://www.kids-cooking-activities.com/kids-Easter-recipes.html</a></p> | <p><b>Directions</b></p> <p>In mixing bowl add all dry ingredients including flour, cinnamon, baking soda, ginger, nutmeg, cloves, salt, brown sugar and white sugar. Stir together and set aside. In smaller bowl add wet ingredients including oil, applesauce, eggs, milk, and vanilla. Blend into dry ingredients with mixer. Stir in carrots, raisins, and nuts. Pour into a greased cake pan or 13 x9 inch pan. (**or use the bunny cake idea below.)
